



Bramley Oak Academy, following extensive discussions with the Local Authority, submitted a Significant Change Document in relation to the number of students on roll at the school with the proposal to increase this from 55 male students to 61 male students. The aim of this proposal was to increase the school's capacity and provide additional needed spaces within the county.

Prior to the submission of the Significant Change Document, the views of related parties were sought. The views of the related stakeholders and anyone who would be potentially impacted by this, were important to the school's proposed expansion and, as a School and Trust, we were keen to have feedback on this proposal. Staff and parents were sent the online consultation as were the adjacent school, Gosden House. A letter was sent to all parents highlighting the proposal and how they could access the online feedback or how they could feedback in writing.

The consultation period commenced on the 12th May 2021 and closed on the 18th June 2021. There were no objections from any parties to the proposal.

Following the submission of the Significant Change Document, the Regional Schools Commissioner approved the request for an increase in the school roll to 61 male pupils.
